Our tea partner, The Rare Tea Company, is an independent tea company based in London. Founded in 2004 by Henrietta Lovell it sources and supplies the world's best tea. Henrietta travels the world seeking out tea-gardens crafting the most delicious leaves, buying directly from the farmers. By sourcing direct from the farms, she is able to secure unique harvests and ensure that they are crafted using sustainable practices to benefit both the land and the people who live on it.

Some of their tea is very rare, with only a few kilos produced each year. Others can be grown on a larger scale. All of them are crafted by skilled men and women on independent farms, not industrially processed by large agri-businesses.
